Notice of Race & Special Instructions

We look forward to seeing you on the water

1. Rules

- 1.1 Racing will be governed by the 2009-2012 Racing Rules of Sailing.
- 1.2 The Yachting New Zealand regulations Part II Category 4 and these sailing instructions shall apply for keel yachts.
- 1.3 Any contact made, however minor, with any navigational mark, shall be reported to the race committee by that yacht or any other yacht witnessing the incident. Competitors shall keep clear of all ships of 500 tonnes net register and upwards. This particularly refers to, but it is not limited to, ships in the main navigational channel.
- 1.4 A boat shall not discharge trash into the water.

2. Entries

- 2.1 Racing is open to all keelboats that meet the requirements of 1.1 Rules above.
- 2.2 Entries will be accepted by Winstone Wallboards Ltd up until Wednesday 3rd February 2010. Fax entries will be accepted on Fax: 0800 329 872, providing the information required on this entry form has been completed.
- 2.3 Late entries may be accepted when accompanied by a late fee of \$50 up until Tuesday 10th February 2010.

3. Race divisions and start times

- The race will be started using a Mark Foy System. Each boat will be allotted a start time with the first boats starting at 1600 hrs. There will be two divisions (a) Non Spinnaker (b) Spinnaker.
- 3.1 Racing is open to all keelboats that meet the requirements of 1.1 Rules above.

4. The Course

The course will be displayed from the warning signal on the Westhaven Tower. Course sheets will be included in the race entry pack, which must be picked up from the registration desk in the Main Hall, RNZYS from 1pm on race day.

5. The Start

- 1555 WARNING SIGNAL**
Sponsors Flag and course number displayed
- 1556 PREPARATORY SIGNAL**
Code Flag "P" displayed
- 1559 ONE MINUTE**
Code Flag "P" removed
- 1600 FIRST START**
Sponsors Flag removed
- 1601 Boats will start when that boats allocated start time is REMOVED**
- 1602 Etc**

PLEASE NOTE: Premature Starters will be penalised 3 places



6. Start and Finish Lines

The start and finish line will be the signal mast on the Westhaven Tower and the Windward edge of the ODM approximately 400 metres from the Tower. All boats not starting shall keep clear of the starting area defined as 100 metres West of the starting line until 10 minutes prior to their allotted start time.

7. Fairway Marks

Bean Rock Light and Beacon – Boats shall pass on the main channel side.
Sandspit marker post – Boats shall pass on the main channel side. Yachts must not enter Ports of Auckland protected mooring areas as defined on Chart NZ5332

8. Race Communication

All radio communications between competitors and the race committee shall be through VHF Channel 77.

9. Disclaimer

All those taking part in the RNZYS races or other sailing events controlled by the RNZYS, as between the RNZYS and each of those so taking part, do so at their own risk and responsibility and the RNZYS or The New Zealand Institute of Architects, has no liability for any damage, loss or penalty suffered by any boat, crew or any other person taking part in such races or events. The RNZYS is not responsible for the seaworthiness of a boat whose entry is accepted and/or the sufficiency and/or adequacy of its equipment or the competence of its skipper or crew. The RNZYS reserves the right in its sole and uncontrolled discretion to refuse any entry.

10. Pre Race Pack

Race pennants, start times and course details must be picked up from the registration desk in the Main Hall at the RNZYS from 1pm on race day. Race pennants must be returned at prize-giving. Parking: please advise your guests parking is only available between the white lines around the RNZYS. Between the yellow lines is a tow-away zone for Berth Owner card holders only. Vehicles will be towed! Parking is also available adjacent to Sitting Ducks restaurant on Westhaven Drive.

11. Safety

Skippers are responsible to ensure crew and guests behave in a considerate and safe manner while on the water. The responsibility for a boats decision to participate in a race or continue racing is hers alone.

12. Post race function

Following the race all are invited to meet at the RNZYS to enjoy drinks and dinner generously provided by the race sponsors. A brief prize-giving and sponsors address will be made at the post race function.

13. Dress Code

Please respect the RNZYS dress code.

(Late entries will incur a \$50 late fee and be accepted until Tuesday 10th February)
